The tender Technical Specifications of the following vehicles (Lot 3):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Item 2 (Patrol vehicle-van type 8+1 seats)</li><li>Item 3 (Dogs transport van, 2+3 seats)</li></ul> <p>Require a diesel engine 2100 cm<sup>3</sup>, power output at least 100kW.</p> <p>For diesel engine with piston displacements ranging between 2100 and 2300 cm<sup>3</sup>, the developed power output stands between 80 kW and 100kW.</p> <p>Therefore, most European manufactures will not be able to meet the tender requirements for a minimum power output of 100kW, and this factor could seriously hamper competition.</p> <p>In light of the above, we hereby stress the need for a suitable tolerance on the engine power output required for Item 2 and 3 (i.e. between 80kW and 100kW), for allowing a participation on equal terms amongst all manufacturers offering equivalent vehicles.</p>	<p>Date: 24 May 2007</p> <p>In Technical Specifications for LOT 3 – Item 2 and 3, it is required 2100 ccm as <b>minimum</b> piston displacement. Therefore, tenderer must comply with demands for both, piston displacement and output power (Engine: diesel, minimum 2100 ccm, at least 100 kW).</p> <p>Further more, according to the Beneficiary's Market research conducted recently, there have been a couple of models matching the requirements of the Technical specifications.</p>
