<p>Date: March, 21st 2007</p> <p>1. Lot 3-Item 4: Digital projector and screen As we have been informed this item is only manufactured in Asia but not in the EU.</p> <p>2. Lot 4-Item 5: School table with 3 tablet chairs Kindly ask you to confirm that one school table with dimensions: 125x50xH75 cm plus 3 pcs. of tablet chairs is requested because the tablets compensate the table. Furthermore the table with the indicated dimensions is too short to place the 3 tablet chairs there.</p>	<p>Date: April , 16th 2007</p> <p>1. According to our market study, products are available in the eligible countries.</p> <p>2. Dimensions of school table with 3 tablet chairs should be 180x60xH75 cm.</p>
<p>Date: April, 2nd 2007</p> <p>1. LOT 1 "Personal Computers" Item 3 requests the organisation of a "Training of System Administrators", but does not specify in which language the training should be done. Can the training be prepared and delivered in English?</p> <p>2. Following our analysis of LOT 2 "Peripherals", for Items 1, 2, 3 and 4, we have noted an inconsistency in the specified duty cycle/Recommended monthly volume of the printers: the specifications state:</p> <p>For Item 1: minimum 5000 pages per month For Item 2: minimum 50.000 per month recommended volume For Item 3: minimum 100.000 pages per month recommended volume</p>	<p>Date: April 16th, 2007</p> <p>1. Lot 1 Item 3 - training can be prepared and delivered in English.</p> <p>2. Lot 2 Items 1, 2, 3 and 4 - Duty cycle should stay per month, in accordance with Technical specifications.</p>

<p>For Item 4: minimum 5000 pages per month</p> <p>Is this a <u>monthly</u> or an <u>annual</u> data? In relation to this aspect, the prices of the printers may be much higher.</p> <p>3. Following our analysis of LOT 4 "Furniture" Item 6, we have noted an inconsistency in the specified dimensions (100x175). Please inform if the correct dimensions are 100x75.</p>	<p>3. Lot 4 Item 6 - dimension of flip chart should be 100x75 cm.</p>
<p>Date: April, 4th 2007</p> <p>1. We have question regarding Item 1 (workstation) in Lot 1 (Personal computers). There is no "Intel Pentium 4 Dual core technology" processors. It can be only Intel Pentium 4 processors or Intel dual core processors. Intel dual core processor with minimum performance is better than Intel Pentium 4 processor with maximum performance. So, could you explain which one do you want?</p> <p>2. Lot 4, Item 1 – Would you accept chairs made of plywood?</p> <p>3. Lot 4, Item 2, 3 and 6 – Please specify what surface do you require – enamel or ceramic?</p> <p>4. Lot 4, Item 4 – Please specify if you require teachers table with drawers (how many?). Please specify if you require upholstered teachers chair.</p> <p>5. Lot 4, Item 6 – Would you accept dimensions 100x150?</p>	<p>Date: April 16th, 2007</p> <p>1. Intel Dual Core processor or AMD equivalent.</p> <p>2. Lot 4 Item 1 - chairs made of plywood are acceptable.</p> <p>3. Lot 4 Item 2, 3 and 6 - for Item 2 - Blackboard – the surface required is enamel, for Item 3 - Whiteboard - any surface which is suitable to use markers is acceptable, for Item 6 - Flipchart is a block of paper with holder. Surface of paper holder is not of any importance.</p> <p>4. Lot 4 Item 4- The table should be equipped with at least two or three drawers. We agree with upholstered teacher's chair.</p> <p>5. Lot 4 Item 6 - Flipchart - acceptable dimensions are 100x75cm, larger flipcharts are acceptable depending on the price.</p>

<p>Date: April, 12th 2007</p> <p>1. Lot 4 Furniture, Item 5, School table with 3 tablet armchair</p> <p>Could you please kindly clarify the meaning of "3tablet armchair". Is it an arm chair with writing pad or just a chair? If it is a chair with writing pad how you will group them with a school table?</p>	<p>Date: April 16th, 2007</p> <p>1. Lot 4 Item 5 - School table with tablet arm chair</p> <p>Tablet arm chair is a chair with round seat that can be lifted up and down by spinning. It has no writing pad, it's just a chair and it is needed for forensic laboratory classroom.</p>
<p>Date: April, 16th 2007</p> <p>LOT 1: PERSONAL COMPUTERS</p> <p>1. In item 1 (Workstation) you required Intel Pentium 4 Dual core technology at min. 3.2 GHz. Do you mean Intel Pentium 4 or Intel Pentium Dual core processors?</p> <p>2. In item 3 (Server) you required 2x Intel Pentium at 3.4 GHz, expandable to 4 CPUs. Would you accept configurations with 2x Intel Xeon processors, expandable to 4 CPUs? Can you specify equivalent AMD processors for the required configuration?</p>	<p>Date: April 16th, 2007</p> <p>1. Lot 1 Item 1 - Intel Dual Core processor or AMD equivalent. Please disregard the stipulation of 3.2 GHZ.</p> <p>2. Lot 1 Item 3 - 2 x Intel Xeon processors, or AMD equivalent expandable to 4 CPUs is acceptable. An example of equivalent processor is AMD Opteron.</p>
