4) *With reference to Annex II (Technical specifications), Item 3:*

What speakers do you require?

(a) Mono OR stereo?

(b) Freestanding/separate OR integrated in monitor OR any solution?

5) *With reference to Annex II (Technical specifications), Item 4:*

You require PC Card slot (Type I/II) which is really a little bit old and not used for a modern devices/cards. Is it possible to offer instead of it a notebook with Express Card slot – OR do you really require PC Card slot for compatibility with older and/or current cards which you have in hand (for example GPRS data modems)? Does your requirement mean that tender offer without PC Card slot in notebook will be rejected (as technically non-conforming)?

6) *With reference to Annex II (Technical specifications), Item 4:*

You require Infrared link (e.g. IrDa) which is really very old interface and not used in modern devices (for example mobile phones). Is it possible to offer instead of it a notebook with Bluetooth interface – OR do you really require Infrared link interface for compatibility with older device which you have in hand (for example mobile phones)? Does your requirement mean that tender offer without Infrared link (e.g. IrDa) in notebook will be rejected (as technically non-conforming)?

7) *With reference to Annex II (Technical specifications), Item 5:*

For what page size should be printing speed 30

4) We prefer stereo speakers integrated in monitor.

5) As Express Card slot can be considered as equivalent to the required PC Card Slot (Type I/II), due to technological progress on the market from the moment of submitting the Technical Specifications, it will be found acceptable.

6) As Bluetooth interface can be considered as equivalent to the required Infrared Link (e.g IrDa), due to technological progress on the market from the moment of submitting the Technical Specifications, it will be found acceptable.

7) Printing speed min. 30 ppm is required for A4 format pages. Hence, the tender is expected to clearly state the printing speed of the offered printer in pages per minute, paper size A4.

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ppm? A3 -or- A4?

Does your requirement also mean that tender offer with no specified page size for 300 ppm print speed will be rejected (as technically non-conforming)?

8) *With reference to Annex II (Technical specifications), Items 5 and 6:*

You require 200.000 pages as recommended monthly volume. But (1) many vendors do not provided this parameter as totally tricky and subjective, but they provide maximal monthly volume and/or monthly duty cycle and (2) no vendor produce office-level printer with recommended monthly volume 200.000 pages, only some of them provide high-end models with 200.000 pages as maximum monthly volume (monthly duty cycle).

Do you really require printer with declaration provided by the producer (in datasheet or in other specification) that recommended monthly volume is 200.000 pages (or even more) OR is it enough to offer printer with maximum monthly volume (monthly duty cycle) 200.000 pages (or even more)? Does offer of printer with maximum monthly volume (monthly duty cycle) 200.000 pages will be accepted as technically conforming?

9) *With reference to Annex II (Technical specifications), Item 1-6:*

You require CE marking as symbolising conformity with all applicable Community provisions and directives. Should be "CE certificate" (Declaration of Conformity) be included in the tender offer? Does your requirement mean that tender offer without "CE certificate" (Declaration of Conformity) will be rejected (as technically non-conforming)?

8) Recommended monthly volume and/or Maximal monthly volume (monthly duty cycle) 200000 pages will be accepted.

9) Tenderer is expected only to confirm that the offered products will bear CE marking.

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
