In point 2.1.4 of the Guidelines for Applicants, it is stated that a co-applicant may not be awarded funds for 2 projects and that an applicant may not be awarded funds for 2 projects under this Call for Proposals.
Is there an option of being awarded funds for 2 grants – once as an applicant and once as a co-applicant; may an association at the same time be a coordinator on one project and a co-applicant with a smaller project role on another project?

According to point 2.1.4 of the Guidelines for Applicants, the limitations are set in place separately for applicants and co-applicants. An eligible legal entity may not be awarded a grant as an applicant on 2 or more projects. Moreover, an eligible legal entity may also not be awarded a grant as a co-applicant on 2 or more projects.

Conclusively, an eligible legal entity may be awarded a maximum of 2 grants under this Call for proposals, once in the capacity of an applicant and once in that of a co-applicant.
