CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

6. Description of the contract

The purpose of the contract is supply of the equipment (hardware and software) for improvement and modernization of the Croatian Early Warning System (CEWS) network for immediate detection of potential contamination in the case of nuclear accident. Realization of the contract should strength capabilities of the State Office for Nuclear Safety (SONS) in assuring of reliable information in the case of nuclear accident with the network of 25 installed gamma dose measuring stations over the entire Croatian territory. Two stations should be supplemented with meteorological equipment and two aerosol (alpha, beta, gamma) monitoring stations which should be installed and integrated in the CEWS. In addition a new integrated central system for reading, analyzing and presenting of the measuring data should be developed, installed, tested and verified.

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see item 22 below). All goods supplied under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. Participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Supply Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the *Practical Guide to contracts procedures for EC external actions*.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers may submit only one tender per lot. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the supplies required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

Tenderers must provide a tender guarantee of **5300 EUR** when submitting their tender. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful tenderers once the tender procedure has been completed and to the successful tenderer(s) upon signature of the contract by all parties. This guarantee will be called upon if the tenderer does not fulfil all obligations stated in its tender.

12. Performance guarantee

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 10% of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next best compliant tender.

14. Tender validity

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders.

15. Period of implementation

The implementation period will last 330 days starting from the day of issuance of the Commencement Order and ending on the day of issuance of the Provisional acceptance certificate. The implementation period includes a delivery period of 120 days.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

The following selection criteria will be applied to tenderers. In the case of tenders submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

- 1) Economic and financial capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. item 3 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
 - a) the annual turnover of the tenderer for the year 2007¹ must be at least two times of the submitted financial proposal
 - b) the cash and cash equivalents of tenderer at the end of the years 2006 and 2007 are positive
- 2) Professional capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. items 4 and 5 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
 - a) at least 5 persons of all permanent staff currently working for candidate are working in the fields related this contract (design, installation or maintenance of radiation early warning or monitoring systems)
- 3) Technical capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. items 5 and 6 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
 - a) the tenderer has successfully completed at least one contract in the fields of radiation early warning or monitoring systems with the budget of at least half of his financial proposal for this tender in the years 2005, 2006, 2007 or 2008
 - b) the tenderer has certificated Quality Assurance (QA) Programme related to the services offered.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator.
