**6. Contract description**

The purpose of the contract is supply of equipment for:

- Stationary portal monitor unit teams, which consist of stationary portal monitor system with automatic detection of nuclear and radioactive materials in vehicles, consignments and on pedestrians, hand held equipment with forensic capabilities and personal radiation detectors (pagers). Fourteen border crossings will be equipped.
- Mobile portal monitor unit teams, which consists of mobile portal monitor system with automatic detection of nuclear and other radioactive materials in vehicles and on pedestrians, installed on the basis of the suitable vehicle. Mobile portal monitor unit teams are expected to be formed and, using suitable vehicles, move from one border crossing to another in order to detect nuclear and radioactive materials. The equipment would be used by custom officers in order to detect illicit trafficking of nuclear and radioactive materials applying default procedures.
